We will draw maps of our route to the Post Office and talk about stamps and post boxes. We will explore differences between old and new toys. We will learn about nocturnal animals, explore their habitats and how they gather their food.	Our learning will be focussed around the 7 areas of learning in the Early Years Foundation Stage. The children will play and learn through our Continuous Provision (we call this Discovery Time) in the classroom, outdoor area and school garden and also through adult lead learning activities. Please bring a named water bottle , warm waterproof coat and bookbag to school every day. Please have wellies in school for our outdoor Welly Wednesday activities. Please bring in a PE kit which will be kept in school on your child's peg and sent home every half term holiday. We will have PE every Thursday with Mr Croucher, our Sports Coach.	Phonics and Reading We will continue to learn new letter sounds and also 'Special Friends' sounds where sounds are made with two letters. Please continue to support your child with the sounds in the little green sound books and use the videos we send home on seesaw too. We will learn to read green words with 'Fred Talk'. <u>Reading Books</u> As they learn to Fred Talk to read words, the children will begin to bring home blending books and then move on to Ditty sheets in a folder and eventually red reading books. Please write in your child's yellow reading record when they practise reading at home.
